In consideration of using the Hampton Chase Pool and Recreation Facilities, the Member(s) agree(s) to abide by the Association Rules and Regulations regarding the facilities.

All persons using the Pool and Recreation Facilities do so at their own risk. The Association assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use or any loss or damage to personal property. Persons using the pool, Pool Area and Recreation Facilities agree to hold the Association harmless for any actions of whatever nature occurring within the Area.

The Pool Staff has my permission in an emergency when I (or my physician) cannot be contacted to take my child to the emergency room of the nearest hospital and the hospital and its medical staff has my permission to provide treatment, which a physician deems necessary for the well being of my child.

Each Member shall be liable to the Association for any costs incurred by the Association including, but not limited to, costs of repair, cleaning, attorney's fees and damages awards, incurred by the Association and rendered necessary by any act, neglect, carelessness or failure of such Owner or their tenants and guests to comply with the Association's Declaration, Bylaws, Policy Resolutions and Rules and Regulations during their use of the Hampton Chase Pool and Recreation Facilities.

The Member agrees that all persons in its household and all sponsored guests shall abide by the HCRA Bylaws and/or Pool Rules and Regulations. The Member agrees that it is their responsibility to ensure their membership passes and related files contain accurate information and are updated as necessary. Members NOT in good standing will NOT be issued pool passes by the HCRA or its Management Company. Pool passes are the property of HCRA and are not transferable. A Member's right of usage may be suspended for violation of the HCRA Bylaws, pool and clubhouse rules, or for failure to pay dues (including any special or damage assessments). Only those Members who are in good standing and hold a valid pass will be admitted.

Hampton Chase Recreation Association offers three (3) types of Membership for access to its Pool and facilities. Documentation shall be required in order to obtain each type of Membership as determined by the Board. The following is a list of membership types that are available as defined in the HCRA Bylaws and/or Pool Rules and Regulations.

- A. Homeowner Membership: A resident property owners with a mandatory membership and who are in good standing with HCRA (including the homeowner and immediate family) as defined in the Bylaws as someone who is a full-time resident of the property and is a grandparent, parent, spouse, step-child, child or grandchild of the Homeowner. For annual registration, proof of ownership and residence will be required.
- B. Resident Membership: A resident tenant and immediate family where the Homeowner Member does not reside in his/her home. The Homeowner Member may (with a power of revocation) transfer his/her pool privileges to the tenant residing there, provided the Homeowner Member is in good standing. Under no circumstances can the Homeowner Member and tenant both hold pool memberships. Documentation will be required to show residence, tenancy and the Homeowner Member's power of revocation. The registered homeowner must notify the HCRA Management Company of the tenant's information so that they can be issued pool passes.
- C. Associate Membership: The Board of Directors is empowered to authorize the sale of Associate Memberships as per the Bylaws. An Associate Membership encompasses the Associate Member and immediate family. Associate Members will need to provide documentation as to their residence in an authorized associate membership area and proof of purchase of an Associate Membership.

Hampton Chase Recreation Association all offers three (3) categories of special access to its Pool and facilities. The following list of special access passes may be requested by a Member in good standing.

- 1. Guests: Guests of a Member (in good standing) are permitted access to the pool when sponsored by a Member who must remain present at all times with their Guests while at the pool. All Guests are subject to the same rules and regulations as Members. A Member assumes full responsibility for their Guest(s) and may be penalized for infractions by their Guest(s) and held responsible for violations by their Guest(s).
- 2. Extended House Guest: A Member (in good standing) may sponsor an Extended-House Guest who resides with the Member for a period in excess of twenty-one (21) days during the pool season. An Extended Pass may be purchased as determined by the Board of Directors. This pass may not be purchased for any person who is an employee of the Member. This pass is available upon presentation of documentation that this person is an actual houseguest.
- 3. Childcare Provider: A Member (in good standing) may sponsor a babysitter, au pair, nanny or childcare provider (who provides care for 20 hours or more per week) to accompany the employing Member's children to the pool. The Childcare Provider's access is a limited, not full time, pass and is restricted to those times when the Childcare Provider is caring for the Member's children. Each Member is responsible for registering the Childcare Provider and for paying any necessary fees as determined by the HCRA Board of Directors. Childcare Providers must be aged 16 or older. The HCRA assumes no responsibility for any acts or failure to act by a Childcare Provider.

The Member shall agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Association, its agents, officers, directors, members, and their successors and assigns from and against any claims, cause of action, loss, damage, cost or charge, including court costs and attorney's fees: (1) as a result of any claims or lawsuits made by third parties against the Association if any third party ever contends that he was personally injured or had property damage caused by the Member or their guest's use of the premises; and (2) for any damage to any property taken onto the Premises.

The signatory of this document hereby certifies and agrees that by signing this document, he or she is acting on behalf of each person of the household and hereby binds each person of his household. Members hereby agree to all terms and conditions governing the Member's use of the HCRA pool and facilities. **Failure to sign and acknowledge this form, along with the Pool Rules and Regulations will result in failure of receiving your 2018 Pool Passes.**
