You can be fined for this offense by FX county.

IAW HOA standards, don't put it out before Tuesday night. We have a process for ticketing offenders, now in place, so if you are a consistent offender, you

will be fined after an appropriate BoD hearing. If you have a lawn service, ensure they take refuse away or only cut on Tuesday.

6. **Annual Yard Sale** Will be held on 28/29 May this coming week. Peggy Ephrath is the PoC.

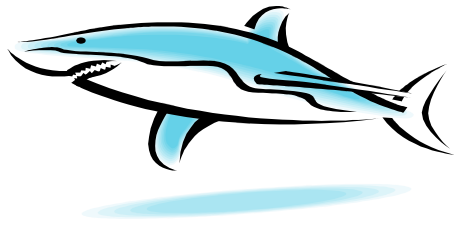
